Camp Guidelines

1. Maple Grove Christian Retreat Center is a smoke free environment.
2. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the grounds
3. Pets should be left at home, otherwise they must be kept on a leash while on the grounds. Please "stoop and scoop". **Note:** Many cottage owners do not allow pets in the cottages that are rented out to our camp.
4. Food trays and dishes are to be left in the dining hall.
5. Shirts and shoes are required in all public areas except the pool deck and sports courts.
6. Groups are asked to observe relative quiet between 11:00pm and 8:00am out of respect for others.
7. Modest and appropriate attire is in order at all times.
8. Bicycles are not to be ridden after dusk and in the Square at all times. Helmets are required. Proper speeds are to be observed as camp is a designated pedestrian area.
9. Language and actions not in keeping with the camp mission statement are not acceptable.
10. The camp is a pedestrian area. Motor vehicles should be used sparingly (15 km/hr).
11. Any campfires must have a full time attendant until the fire is extinguished.
